The Gift of NFOP Membership

Give someone you know the gift of help and support

If you know someone that you believe would benefit from being a Member of the National Federation of Occupational Pensioners (NFOP), for example a friend, relative or neighbour, you can buy them membership as a gift.

How to gift NFOP membership

You can gift membership of NFOP by completing the form opposite and sending it back to Headquarters using the FREEPOST address given at the top of the form.

The membership team at Headquarters will set up the new Member and process the subscription as per the gift option chosen on the form; one, two or five years membership.

Headquarters will send out a welcome pack, gift certificate and covering letter to the person who has been gifted membership confirming their member details. The letter will name the person who has gifted their membership and for what period of time.

A gifted membership includes all the benefits and services of an ordinary membership, including use of all the NFOP Helplines, the magazine and automatic eligibility to be part of a local Branch.

When the gifted membership is due to expire we will write to the member offering them the chance to renew. Any subscription due at renewal will become the responsibility of the renewing member.
